In a 1 to 0 vote, Will Kenny from Trepassey, NL, was evicted and sent to the jury house, leaving Kaela, Derek, and Paras to battle it out in a final three fight to the finish line. Thursday night, fans can tune in to find out who will be crowned the winner of *Big Brother Canada* in the epic two-hour Season 6 finale at **8 p.m. ET/PT** on **Global**.
