



CORUS ENTERTAINMENT ANNOUNCES VOTING RESULTS FROM ANNUAL MEETING OF SHAREHOLDERS

TORONTO, January 20, 2022 – Corus Entertainment Inc. (TSX: CJR.B) announced today the voting results from its Annual Meeting of Shareholders (the “Meeting”) held virtually via online webcast on January 19, 2022.

A total of 3,263,428 Class A participating shares (“Class A Voting Shares”), representing 95.63% of the Company’s 3,412,392 issued and outstanding Class A Voting Shares, were voted in connection with the Meeting. All matters put forth at the Meeting, including the election of directors, the appointment of auditors and authorization of the directors to fix the remuneration of such auditors, were approved by a large majority of the voting shareholders as detailed in the Company’s filing on www.sedar.com.

Each of the ten (10) director nominees set out in the Company’s Management Information Circular dated December 9, 2021 was elected to hold office until the next Annual Meeting of Shareholders or until their successors are elected or appointed.
